

In the event of a fire...

It is the responsibility of the **Leader in Charge** to make sure everyone knows what to do in the event of a fire.

- **ALL occupants should leave the building immediately. The group should assemble on the back lawn as far away from the house as possible. Leaders should check everyone is accounted for.**
- **Leaders should make sure everyone knows what to do in the event of a fire as soon as possible after arrival at the house.**
- **Leaders should show the group all fire exits and show how these doors can be opened. You should take the group out and show where to assemble outside.**
- **There are two fire exits at the bedroom side of the house. The main hall has one fire exit door and another two exits leading to the front door and the kitchen door.**
- **Leaders are advised to carry a mobile phone at all times in case of an emergency. If there is a fire call 999 straight away. The house is NOT connected to an automatic alarm system.**
- **Fire Appliances are supplied in accordance with regulations and are checked annually. Smoke alarms are wired directly to the electricity.**

DO NOT obstruct the Fire Exits in any way.
